The Washington County Freedom Colonies Exhibit in Belle's Alley relates undertold stories of local history. The colonies were established in the late years of the Civil War and after emancipation, as the formerly enslaved began to find their way in freedom.

These colonies took root during a volatile time in our history, and became places where Blacks could feel safe. gain a sense of community, and begin living their lives as freedmen.

The Freedom Colonies normally grew around a church, a cemetery, and often a school and businesses.

Learn the story of why, and how, these colonies developed and about a number of colonies established here in Washington County.


